UF-IFAS Impact:

Dennis affected Research and Education Centers (REC) located in the following Counties: Dade, Gadsden, Hillsborough, Okaloosa, and Santa Rosa.
Katrina affected RECs in Broward and Dade Counties.

FSU Impact:

Dennis - Most of the damages were due to water which included roof leaks (wind and quantity driven), flooding and erosion issues at the Turkey Point Marine Lab.

FAMU Impact:

Dennis - Damages to the Public Health Entomology Research & Education Center in Panama City were a result of storm surge, flooding and erosion.

USF Impact:

Katrina - Tree damage due to high winds.

FAU Impact:

Katrina - Limited damage due to high winds and debris clean-up.

UWF Impact:

Dennis - Approximately 50 facilities received water and/or wind damage.
Katrina - Costs were limited to preparation and debris removal.

FIU Impact:

Katrina - A total of 28 facilities received some damage. Substantial wind damage to at least 3 buildings resulting in roof damage and water intrusion. The fume hood stacks were blown down on three research buildings. Leaks in other location seem to be associated with caulking, the seal around openings and just the driving force of the wind around and under doors and windows. The facility with the most roof damage was the Engineering Center. Mold mitigation has not been taken into account. FIU is aggressively addressing the water intrusion challenges to prevent long term indoor air quality problems.

FGCU Impact:

Katrina - Costs are associated with securing facilities, providing police and housing operations during university closure (one day), computing services, student counseling, and other offices maintained extended hours to prepare for closure and re-opening.
