SUBJECT: Consideration of a State University System Undergraduate Tuition Increase

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Motion:

Move that the Board mandate each university to raise undergraduate tuition 5 percent (\$3.68 per credit hour), effective with the Spring 2008 term. Further, a minimum of 30 percent of the revenues generated by this tuition increase should be allocated to need-based financial aid.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Section 7(d), Article IX, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

At its meeting on July 10, 2007, the Board of Governors stated that it would “raise undergraduate tuition and fees for Spring 2008, not to exceed five percent....”

The Board will decide the amount of the undergraduate tuition increase and establish its implementation date.
