SUBJECT: Public Notice of Intent to Repeal Board of Governors Regulation 6C-10.009
for Smoking in Public Buildings

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve Public Notice of Intent to Repeal Regulation 6C-10.009 relating to Smoking in Public Buildings on the Board of Governor's Web site pursuant to the Board's Regulation Development Procedure.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Section 7(d), Art. IX, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Regulation 6C-10.009 Smoking in Public Buildings regulation was adopted for the purpose of implementing Section 255.27, Florida Statutes, which has been eliminated. Section 20, Article X of the state constitution prohibits tobacco smoking in enclosed indoor workplaces. This prohibition was adopted in 2002. Additionally, the constitution states that "... nothing in this section or in its implementing legislation or regulations shall prohibit the owner, lessee, or other person in control of the enclosed indoor workplace from further prohibiting or limiting smoking there." The Constitution charges the Legislature with implementing this section, which has been done via the Florida Clean Indoor Air Act, 386.201-386.212 FS.
