## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Facilities Committee, at its meeting January 23, 2008, directed staff to provide further information on selected items presented. Following is this information:

Question: BOG Facilities staff indicated that only 42% of research space need has been met on the USF Main Campus. Is this correct, and how is this possible?

Answer: This figure has been verified by USF and includes the Health Science Center Facilities. It does not include the St. Pete Campus facilities. If the USF System is taken as a whole, including all FTE and all space, the same percentage of need met (42%) is obtained. USF Tampa, including USF Health and the College of Marine Science leases 586,407 square feet, at an annual cost of \$12,284,275. With the construction of more research space, USF could reduce this operating expense and believes it could obtain additional research grants that its space limitations preclude it from applying for.

Question: Why did the Florida Department of Transportation provide funds to UF for Pugh Hall construction?

The FDOT provided almost \$1 million to the University of Florida used for construction of the recently completed Pugh Hall. UF sited the facility to accommodate existing underground infrastructure belonging to FDOT.

How are the Universities reporting Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) spending to the DMS Office of Supplier Diversity?

The universities report MBE information on a quarterly basis directly to the Department of Management Services Office of Supplier Diversity, as well as the Florida Board of
