**PROPOSED BOARD ACTION**

Approve public notice of intent to amend Regulation 3.006 for publication on the Board of Governors Web site pursuant to the Board's regulation development procedure.

**AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION**

Section 7(d), Article IX, Florida Constitution

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Regulation 3.006 currently requires the university president to report accreditation visits and send copies of accreditation reports and supporting documents to the Chancellor.

The regulation has been amended to require the university boards of trustees to develop regulations on accreditation. With regard to regional accreditation, the original requirement that the university president notify the Chancellor of SACS accreditation visits has been preserved, but the reporting requirement has changed to allow universities to produce accreditation documentation at the request of the Board Office. In the added section on discipline-specific accreditation, universities are encouraged to seek specialized accreditation when available or to provide the Office of the Board of Governors with the rationale for not doing so as part of the State University System Accreditation Survey.

This regulation has been reviewed by the university general counsels, Council of Academic Vice Presidents (CAVP), and the State University System academic contacts.

Pursuant to the regulation procedure adopted by the Board at its March 23, 2006 meeting, the Board is required to provide public notice by publication on its Internet Web site at least 30 days before adoption of the proposed regulation.
