SUBJECT: Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 6.010 –
Student Affairs Administration

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve public notice of intent to amend Regulation 6.010 for publication on the Board of Governors Web site pursuant to the Board's regulation development procedure.

AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION

Section 7(d), Article IX, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Regulation 6.010 provides requirements for university boards of trustees to establish regulations governing student affairs and to publish a student handbook annually. The student handbook should be available to students either electronically or in print, and include at least the following information:

- a comprehensive academic calendar;
- information related to student conduct and student rights;
- requirements for articulation in Florida;
- contact information for the university ombudsman; and
- information related to acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS).

This regulation has been reviewed by the university general counsels, Council of Academic Vice Presidents, Council for Student Affairs, and academic contacts.

Pursuant to the regulation procedure adopted by the Board at its March 23, 2006 meeting, the Board is required to provide public notice by publication on its Internet Web site at least 30 days before adoption of the proposed regulation.
