## PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve public notice of intent to amend Regulation 6.018 for publication on the Board of Governors Web site pursuant to the Board's regulation development procedure.

## **AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION**

Section 7(d), Article IX, Florida Constitution

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Regulation 6.018 provides further clarification of acceptable documentation required for substitution or modification of requirements for program admission, undergraduate transfer, and graduation by students with disabilities. The amendment strikes specified categories of disabilities, thereby providing equal coverage for any student with a disability who meets specified documentation requirements.

This regulation has been reviewed by the State University System disability service providers, Council for Student Affairs, general counsels, academic contacts, and Council of Academic Vice Presidents.

Pursuant to the regulation procedure adopted by the Board at its March 23, 2006 meeting, the Board is required to provide public notice by publication on its Internet Web site at least 30 days before adoption of the proposed regulation.
