BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The 6C-8.001 University Calendars regulation is amended to update references related to governance and to be in alignment with State Board of Education Rule, 6A-10.019, "Required Annual Calendar for Schools and Colleges." Alignment of calendars is necessary in order to facilitate the timely progression of students from one educational sector to another, and between institutions in the same sector.

New College of Florida's 4-1-4 structure of class terms necessitate "spring" term starting usually in late January. The regulation is amended to allow for a permanent exception so that the university does not have to seek approval each year.
