BOG ISSUE: Authority to Name Buildings



PROPOSED STATUTORY LANGUAGE: Statutory Language To Be Developed

1. Need for Change: Sections 267.062 and 1013.79(11), Florida Statutes The Board of Governors would be delegated the authority by the legislature to name university buildings after living persons.

2. Current Condition:

Universities and the State Board of Education now have the authority to name buildings in honor of a donor, but require legislative approval to name a building after a living person.

4. Fiscal Impact:

Expenditures would be limited to signage required for the buildings and appropriate roadway signage.
