BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1008.46, Florida Statutes, requires the State University System to submit an annual accountability report. The Legislature has identified 27 measures, which are included by reference in the Implementing Bill of the General Appropriations Act (GAA) and are directly linked to the appropriations made in the Act.

Although this report attempts to cover the tripartite (instruction, research, and service) mission of SUS institutions, 85% of its measures are associated with instruction. Other notable differences between this report and the accountability system adopted by the Board of Governors are that the Board's system addresses student learning outcomes in the form of Academic Learning Compacts; pertinent measures, including targeted degree production, are associated with year 2012 goals; and the Board's system includes its in-process "Measure Eight" regarding fiscal accountability.
