Termination of the Ed.D. and the Ph.D. in Student Personnel in Higher Education at the University of Florida (Classification of Instructional Program Code 13.1102)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The University of Florida (UF) has requested that both the Ph.D. and the Ed.D. degree programs in Student Personnel in Higher Education be terminated. These degrees have been inactive since 2000. No students have been enrolled in these programs since 2002. Termination of these programs will have no impact on enrollment, enrollment planning, or reallocation of resources. The master's degree in Student Personnel in Higher Education will continue to be offered. Students interested in studying Student Personnel in Higher Education at the doctoral level will be able to do so through the Higher Education Administration doctoral program.

The terminations of these programs were formally approved by UF's Board of Trustees on May 14, 2008. If approved by the Board of Governors, these terminations will be effective in July 2008.
