BOG ISSUE: Challenge Grant Local Match



PROPOSED STATUTORY LANGUAGE: 1013.79 University Facility

Enhancement Challenge Grant Program.--

(2) There is established the Alec P. Courtelis University Facility Enhancement Challenge Grant Program for the purpose of assisting universities build high priority instructional and research-related capital facilities, including common areas connecting such facilities. The associated foundations that serve the universities shall solicit gifts from private sources to provide matching funds for capital facilities. For the purposes of this <u>section act</u>, private sources of funds shall not include any federal; <u>or</u> state; <u>or local</u> government funds that a university may receive.

1. Need for Change: This change would encourage mutually beneficial partnerships between universities and local government entities.

2. Current Condition: The universities, unlike the state community colleges, are not permitted to request facility matching dollars for contributions from local government entities.

3. Effect of the Change: The proposed policy change would provide statutory consistency so that all public higher education delivery systems have equal opportunity to participate in facility challenge grant programs. The proposed language parallels the current community college statute.

4. Fiscal Impact:

The justification for this change is to address campus facility needs, by including additional potential revenue sources.
