Drink Specials: Research*

- Specials encourage high consumption levels
- Higher cost less consumption
- 10 cent increase 30% reduction intoxication
- Least intoxicated \$4.44 for 14 grams alcohol
- Most intoxicated \$1.81 for 14 grams alcohol
