Board of Governors Staff Analysis of the Florida International University (FIU) and the  
University of Central Florida (UCF) Medical School Proposals  
November 15, 2005

Throughout the FIU proposal, the number of residencies is consistently estimated at 500. However, subsequent to submitting its proposal, the University has advised BOG staff that a more accurate estimate is 250. The 500 number appears within the staff analysis on pages 28, 32, 37, and 44 of the agenda.

The potential number of New Medical Doctor Graduates projected by Year 10 is 642 for FIU and 640 for UCF, rather than the 480 and 420 respectively, as contained within the staff analyses on pages 27 and 50 of the agenda. Degrees granted by year 10 was not contained as a discrete number in either medical school proposal and had to be estimated from projected enrollments to arrive at the potential number of new medical doctor graduates. The original calculations have been revised upward to reflect the total projected enrollments over the first seven years, as these would be the students who could conceivably be graduates. However, the revised numbers assume that the universities will meet their enrollment projections by 100 percent and that all students will be retained for the full length of the program.

On page 34 of the agenda (page 8 of the FIU staff analysis), the third sentence under the response to Budget question number 9, "UCF" should be "FIU".

On page 45 of the agenda (page 19 of the FIU staff analysis), the last sentence under the analysis for question number 23 should state "earlier in the proposal" not "earlier the proposal."
