BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Annually, the Board of Governors must prepare and submit a State University System (SUS) Legislative Budget Request for state appropriated operating funds. For the first time, effective with the 2005-2006 fiscal year, the Board of Governors' staff and budget are reflected in a separate budget entity in the General Appropriations Act. Both budgets must be reviewed and recommendations made on the issues to be included in the 2006-2007 LBR.

On April 22, 2005, the Chancellor requested that the University Boards of Trustees submit their institutions' budget priorities for 2006-2007. System issues such as enrollment growth, major gift matching, plant operations and maintenance for new and phased-in space, and medical and law school phase-in would be handled by the Board of Governors' staff. The Chancellor has received the universities' top priorities and a LBR workshop will be conducted to review the information.
