
FLORIDA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY Nursing Demand HEALTH INITIATIVES

- 126,000 Registered Nurses needed now in U. S. hospitals.
- Department of Labor projects a cumulative need for over **1 million** new registered nurses by 2010.









Shortage of Nursing Faculty

HEALTH INITIATIVES

- National deficit is now 1,000.
- 12% shortfall of nursing faculty predicted for Southern states.
- 18% of Florida's Nursing Faculty are expected to retire this year.

Enrollment Limitations

HEALTH INITIATIVES

- · National shortage of nursing faculty.
- MSN-prepared nurses earn between \$80,000 and \$90,000; BUT University salaries range from \$45,000 for 9 months to \$60,000 for 12 months.
- Florida Board of Nursing statutes require a 1:12 faculty student ratio.
- Access to clinical and classroom facilities

Capacity

HEALTH INITIATIVES

- FIU has the space and facilities to add 70 nursing students using existing facilities.
- However, 7 more faculty plus an administrator will be required to expand the programs.
- Expansion costs are estimated at 1 million dollars

Fall 2004 - The FIU beginning Bachelor of Science in Nursing program had 166 qualified applicants but could only accept 70 students because of the faculty shortage.

- Previously attended Miami Dade and Broward Community Colleges.
- 90 to 95% remain in South Florida after graduation.

HEALTH INITIATIVES

Demand

Huge unmet demand for nurses that will only increase in the future.

Supply

Opportunity to expand and solve the shortage problem:

- 1. Main constraint is faculty
- 2. Need to ramp up and support nursing PhD programs
- 3. Increase diversity of nurses in Florida and the nation
- 4. Add space and facilities
- 5. Identify more clinical sites
