SUS SPACE ALLOCATION AND UTILIZATION

- What is the current allocation of space by category in the State University System? Exhibit A
Answer:

Office	29%
Campus Support Services	26%
Research Laboratory	13%
Teaching Laboratory	9%
Study	7%
Classroom	6%
Teaching Gymnasium	5%
Auditorium/Exhibition	4%
Instructional Media & Student Academic Support	1%

- What proportion of total space in the State University System is classroom space? Exhibit A
Answer: 6%

- What factors are utilized to determine classroom space needs and to assess classroom space utilization? Exhibits B,C,D
Answer: Student Station Size
Hours Per Week Used
Student Station Occupancy Rate

- What is the gap between total classroom space utilization capacity and the currently defined classroom space utilization standard? Exhibit E
Answer: Since the current classroom utilization standard does not require classrooms to be used and fully occupied 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, there is a gap between the standard and total classroom space utilization. Determining the gap is dependent on a definition of total classroom space utilization.
