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
Advisory Council on Educational Facilities

An Educational Facilities Analysis Task Force (renamed Advisory Council on Educational Facilities) will be appointed to render to the State Board of Education by December 16, 2003 (revised to February, 2004) recommendations relating to educational facilities in the K-20 education system in Florida. The Council will meet at least monthly and will make periodic reports to the State Board of Education. Objectives for the Council will be:

- Review and evaluate the facilities planning process for K-20
- Review and evaluate the facilities budgeting process for K-20
- Review and evaluate facilities planning and budgeting processes used by comparable growth states
- Review and evaluate needs for existing K-20 facilities
- Review and evaluate needs for proposed K-20 facilities
- Review forming alliances with non-public education institutions and/or community organizations
- Review alternatives to minimize the construction of additional K-20 facilities
- Review sources available to meet facilities funding requirements
- Review methods for distribution of funds to sectors and to agencies within sectors
- Recommend alternatives to minimize facilities funding needs, any necessary revisions in the facilities planning and budgeting processes, alternative funding sources, and methods for distributing available resources

The composition of the Council will consist of representatives appointed by the Commissioner from the groups listed below. The Chief [Education] Financial Officer will serve as the Chairman.
