Paul E. Lingenfelter became Executive Director of SHEEO (State Higher Education Executive Officers) in June 2000. His work at SHEEO has focused on increasing successful participation in higher education including: strengthening student preparation by building stronger relationships with K-12 educators, improving the quality of teaching, developing accountability systems that contribute to improved performance, improving mechanisms for developing state higher education policy, and developing the data systems and financial policies needed to achieve educational improvement.
