 - Eight Imperatives Adopted by State Board
 - Each Imperative has Measurable Objectives and Associated Funding Assumptions
- <u>Priority Three</u>: Other Financial Obligations
 - Client services for Vocational Rehabilitation and Blind Services
 - Annualization of New Programs
 - Restoration and Renovation of Facilities
 - Partially Funded or Phased-In Projects
- <u>Priority Four</u>: Funds Allocated to Local Boards to Respond to Community Needs and Institution-Level Strategic Plans
