### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The University of Florida (UF) is seeking to elevate the existing Nutritional Sciences concentration in the Ph.D. in Food Science and Human Nutrition (FSHN) program to a standalone degree program. The program will require 90 credit hours beyond the baccalaureate degree. Funding will be reallocated from the FSHN program, and expenses will be minimal as the program continues to utilize faculty and facilities currently used for the concentration. The University anticipates an enhanced likelihood of acquiring training grant support because of the interdisciplinary breadth and depth of faculty expertise.
