Key Initiatives & Investments (within 3 years)

- 1. Academic Excellence Implement the 3-year plan for growth by: adding 40 faculty positions to enhance the depth and breadth of course offerings; increasing the number of high-impact pedagogical practices; and reinforcing fundamental writing and quantitative skills.
- 2. Student Development Enhance the first year program, promote well-being through performance and community building, meet expanding needs for disability and counseling services, formalize diversity and inclusion programming, and strengthen career development.
- 3. Infrastructure Design and build a multi-purpose facility to accommodate enrollment growth. Add residence halls with P3 funding. Renew IT infrastructure and address ADA accessibility.
