Key Initiatives & Investments (within 3 years)

- **1. Top 25** After advancing to #38, FSU continues on its path to become a top 25 public university. Through the support provided as a preeminent institution and resources from private partners, we are beginning the first phase of a transformative strategic campaign focused on increasing faculty, graduate education, and the research enterprise.
- **2. Student Success** FSU's 4-year graduation rates are now among the top 15 in the country. FSU will continue to elevate the quality of our undergraduate education by increasing student participation in high impact practices and experiential learning.
- 3. Entrepreneurship and Innovation Education In Fall 2017 FSU will open the Jim Moran School of Entrepreneurship. Offering an interdisciplinary major in entrepreneurship, the school will be a focal point for collegiate entrepreneurial education. In addition, the Jim Moran Institute for Global Entrepreneurship will continue to expand throughout Florida. FSU will open a student innovation hub, advancing career preparation through the development of design-thinking, problem-solving, and technological-innovation skills.
