



 - Online access to library services



Question 8: How is FAU covering the cost of distance education not covered by the fee?

Technology and Infrastructure

Office of Information Technology: cost in infrastructure and software (E&G and Auxiliary Funds)

Center for eLearning covers instructional technology software, proctoring and captioning costs (DL Fees)

Student Services Support Units

Cover front line personnel costs paid by unit budgets (E&G funds and Student Fees)

The Center for eLearning supplements technology, training, multimedia development and coordination (DL Fees)
