



Division of Journalism students are required to complete a minimum of 125 semester hours to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in Journalism or Public Relations. A student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be admitted to the program. To graduate, a student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.4 and a minimum 2.5 GPA in major courses

Students must earn at least an "A" and a "B" in ENC 1101 and ENC 1102. Students who fail to meet this requirement must earn a "B" or better in ENC2300 to enroll in JOU 1040. Students must have a 2.0 minimum GPA to enroll in JOU 1040.


- Student must earn "C's" or better in six semester hours of math.
- Student must earn six credits in natural science courses.
- Student must earn "C's" or better in general education courses.

A student must earn "C's" or better in at least eight credit hours of any foreign/sign language. A student who has completed foreign language in high school may take a placement test to determine the appropriate course level.

Cognate Requirements and Electives (Six Semester Hours)
Public Relations Track students must complete MAR 3023 Principles of Marketing and MAR 4323 Principles of Advertising.

\*If a student completes foreign/sign language or MMC 2000/MMC2100 (Intro to Mass Media/Journalism Mass Media) courses while attending a community college, the student may be required to complete additional general education or liberal arts courses.


