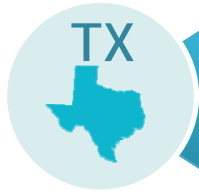

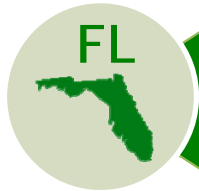

Key Conclusions

- While FL is lower in the # of faculty compared to other states, FL is #3 in R&D per faculty ratio
- A higher ratio means that SUS faculty are successful in securing **the more competitive and larger research awards**
