








Past Year Substance Use Disorders with Any Mental Illness, by Age Group: Percentages






Alcohol - 2 week prevalence of 5+ Drinks & 30 day prevalence of Daily Use by Age Groups

CLINICIAN INDEX OF CLIENT CONCERNS


