BACKGROUND INFORMATION

To promote the impact of online education in the State University System and to recognize the accomplishments of individual online students, the Committee will recognize Mrs. Lauren Apodaca who has achieved a degree in early childhood education through the FIU Online program.

Lauren achieved a bachelor's degree from the FIU Online program despite an ongoing battle with Guillain-Barre' Syndrome, a serious and rare disorder in which the immune system attacks the nervous system and causes respiratory arrest and paralysis. Unable to participate as a residential campus student, while rehabilitating, Lauren enrolled in FIU Online and was appreciative of the steadfast accommodation, support, and encouragement provided by FIU faculty and administrators.

Lauren is currently a fifth grade teacher and attributes much of her success to the FIU Online program. She has stated: "I do not think I would be where I am now had it not been for FIU Online."
