Florida's Common Prerequisites System

- **Goal:** Design an **accessible**, **responsive** and **interactive** system for all degree programs in Florida, and assist students and advisors with their education and graduation planning.
- This is the first step in a major re-architecting of FloridaShines systems, to develop and build a comprehensive advising system.
- This project addresses requirements gathering for the improvement and accessibility of a legislative mandate: "Serve as the official statewide repository for the common prerequisite manual, admissions information for transferring programs, foreign language requirements, residency requirements, and statewide articulation agreements." (s. 1006.735 (4) (b) (5)).



Building the System

- Building a robust database (and its linkages to other databases of record), which also includes the process for converting the current data source to the new database format.
- Developing a user-friendly interface for the manual.
- Providing **administrative access** and the automation of the approval workflow (which allows for changes within the manual).




Database Update

- Working Pilot with existing database updates
 - ~75% of programs completed and converted
- Comprehensive Testing of Business Rules
 - Standardize Data Format
 - Incorporate Institution-specific requirements
 - Standardize all exceptions (requires new business rules)
- Goal: Convert 100% of database
