Please accept this summary of the University of South Florida's presidential search process, as required by Florida Board of Governors Regulation 1.002. We embarked on this search process with a clear vision of a leader who could continue USF's success as a thriving preeminent research university and take our university to the next level. Throughout this process we were attentive to the views of all USF communities; transparent in our processes and grounded in our strategic priorities and mission.

After a thorough nationwide search, which resulted in a strong finalist pool of four highly regarded academic leaders, the Board of Trustees unanimously selected Dr. Steve Currall as the seventh president of the University of South Florida on March 22, 2019.
