Provide a Brief Update on Plan to Improve 4yr Graduation Rates

- Several academic initiatives developed to ensure correct path for degree completion including; closely advising each student with priority advising & registration for all new students, faculty mentors connect students to career goals, common exams and syllabus to ensure consistent and rigorous standard, implemented Scheduling Wizard for students to optimize course offerings, summer course schedules allow a pathway to "catch-up" for students who get off track, and Academic Affairs Support Services regularly meets to address gaps and ways to improve retention/graduation rates - Curricular enhancements include; common freshman year for nearly all majors, creating peer cohorts and time to acclimate to our rigorous STEM curriculum without the burden of potential lost credit if they change majors, and continuous feedback to students and early-alert systems

- Financial Aid is packaged to incentivize students to limit work during the year. Proactive Financial Aid Literacy Counseling is in place to support students' self assessment and options for resolving unmet need. In addition, active counseling of students is in place to use the Florida Student Assistance Grant (FSAG).
