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Our solution relies on creating a culture of responsibility towards oneself and others AND facilitating this culture with Institutional Actions

- **Personal Health Responsibility**
 - Personal Behaviors
 - Health Monitoring; Hygiene; Self-Reporting; Self-Isolation; Six Feet of Separation
 - Assistance to Health Responsibility
 - Personal Equipment; Face Coverings; Remote Work; Accommodations
- **Building Management**
 - Operational Behavior
 - Enhanced Cleaning; Research Laboratory Management
 - Changes and Upgrade
 - Traffic Flow; Indoor Airflows and Improvements; Touchless Entries; Body Temperature Monitoring Stations; Partitions; Furniture Configuration; New Study Space; Use of Outdoor Space
- **Personal Commitment and Learning**
 - Campus Health Campaign Empowering Students; Training for All; Signage; COVID-19 Commitment for Students; Compliance for All; Extra-curricular Planning Requirement



- **Residence Halls**
 - Changes in operation
 - Common areas modified to support physical distancing; Isolation and quarantine spaces set aside; Carefully managed student move-in
- **Dining Services**
 - Changes in operation
 - Changes in indoor seating to encourage appropriate physical distancing; Increased outdoor seating; Changes in service times and meal delivery; Increased alternative food options and delivery
- **Recreation, Activities and Athletics**
 - Changes Based on Guidance of the ACHA
 - SDC reopen in July with new policies; Physically distanced intramural sports; Fitness classes with distance (outside); Virtual Student Union

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COVID-19 Virus Testing



- **Medical Advisory Board** for guidance on issues that strongly intersect with medical practice and infection spread
 - ∅ Provides a mechanism to operationalize CDC guidance and adapt appropriately to our campus
 - ∅ Expert panel with individuals from:
 - § Local providers: Lakeland Regional Health, Advent Hospital, Baycare
 - § Medical Schools in the SUS: University of Florida, University of South Florida, University of Central Florida, Florida International University
- **Screening/Testing Protocol**
 - Developed based on existing screenings and enhanced by our Medical Advisory Board
 - Residential students—health assessment and possibly testing at move-in
 - On-campus testing upon recommendation of Campus Health Clinic
- **Test Delivery**
 - Discussions underway—two local health care providers capable of delivering onsite



- **App-based Screening Assessment**
 - Baseline screening directs next steps, constructed as a “no record” system that informs users of their responsibilities
 - Campus campaign reminding persons to complete self-assessment
 - Used for each campus visit
- **Surveillance: Temperature Monitoring**
 - Non-contact thermal camera systems in high traffic entrances configured to be:
 - 20 seconds from entrance
 - Semi-private
 - Investigating a surveillance app option for campus
- **Tracing**
 - Working with Florida Department of Health, Polk County to coordinate reporting and contact tracing support



- **Three Instructional Formats**
 - FLEX: Face-to-Face with full remote capacity for all materials
 - Lab-Based: Lecture may be remote, lab portion in person
 - Online Engaged: Fully online and includes synchronous engagement for students in addition to asynchronous delivery
- **Computing & Modality Preparedness**
 - Established minimum recommended standards and options
 - Orientation materials for success in new modalities
- **Class Sizes**
 - Managed to create social distance in classrooms and the building, will require some classes to go online (~20% credit hours) and some to use a seat reservation system
- **Academic Support Services**
 - Face-to-Face and Virtual
- **Scheduling and Calendar**
 - Shift in calendar: Early start and instruction fully remote after Thanksgiving.
- **Reasonable Accommodations**
 - Available for students and faculty



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
