- 4) What are the starting salaries of graduates working in Florida?



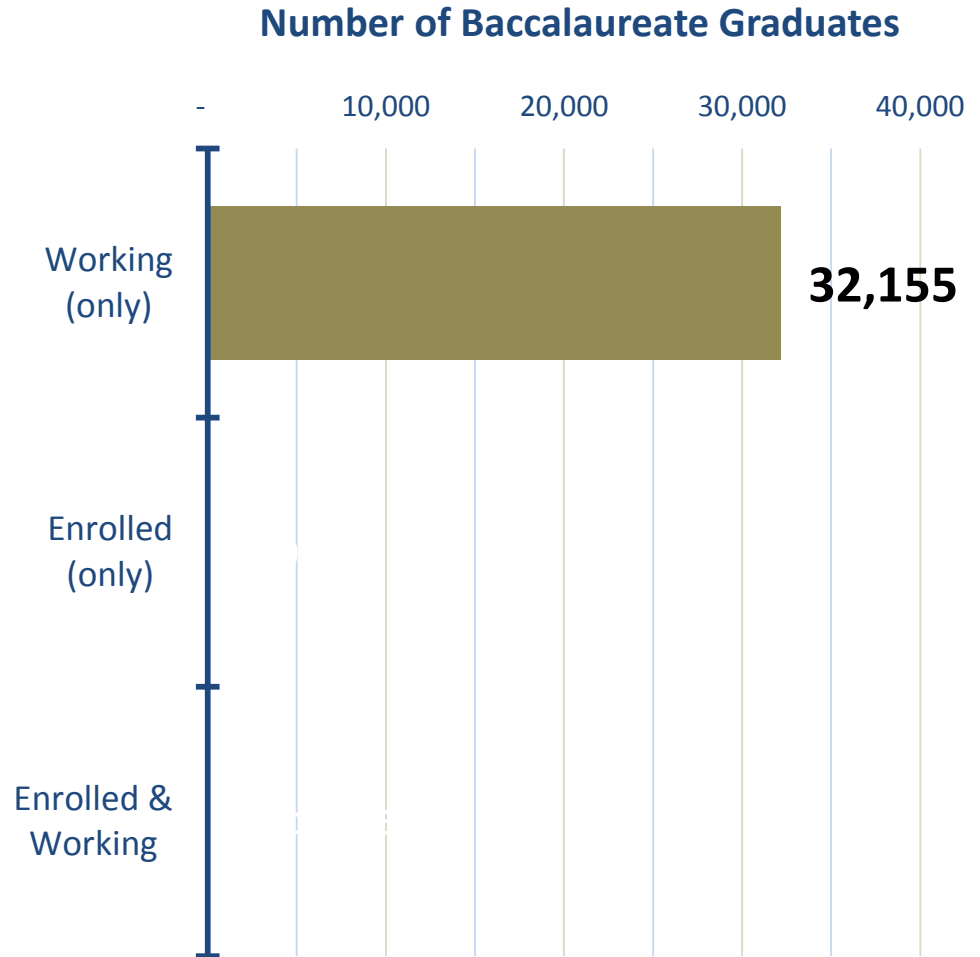
# The Baccalaureate Class of 2012

- The Baccalaureate Class of 2012
  - 56,161 graduates
  - 86% (48,098) matched to an outcome
- The report presents information on the System and academic disciplines, not institutions
- Workforce outcomes for Florida only; Academic outcomes nation-wide



# Do Baccalaureate Graduates Get Jobs in Florida?

- **Yes.**
- **32,155 – or 67% – of graduates were working (only)**
  - 66% full-time, 34% part-time



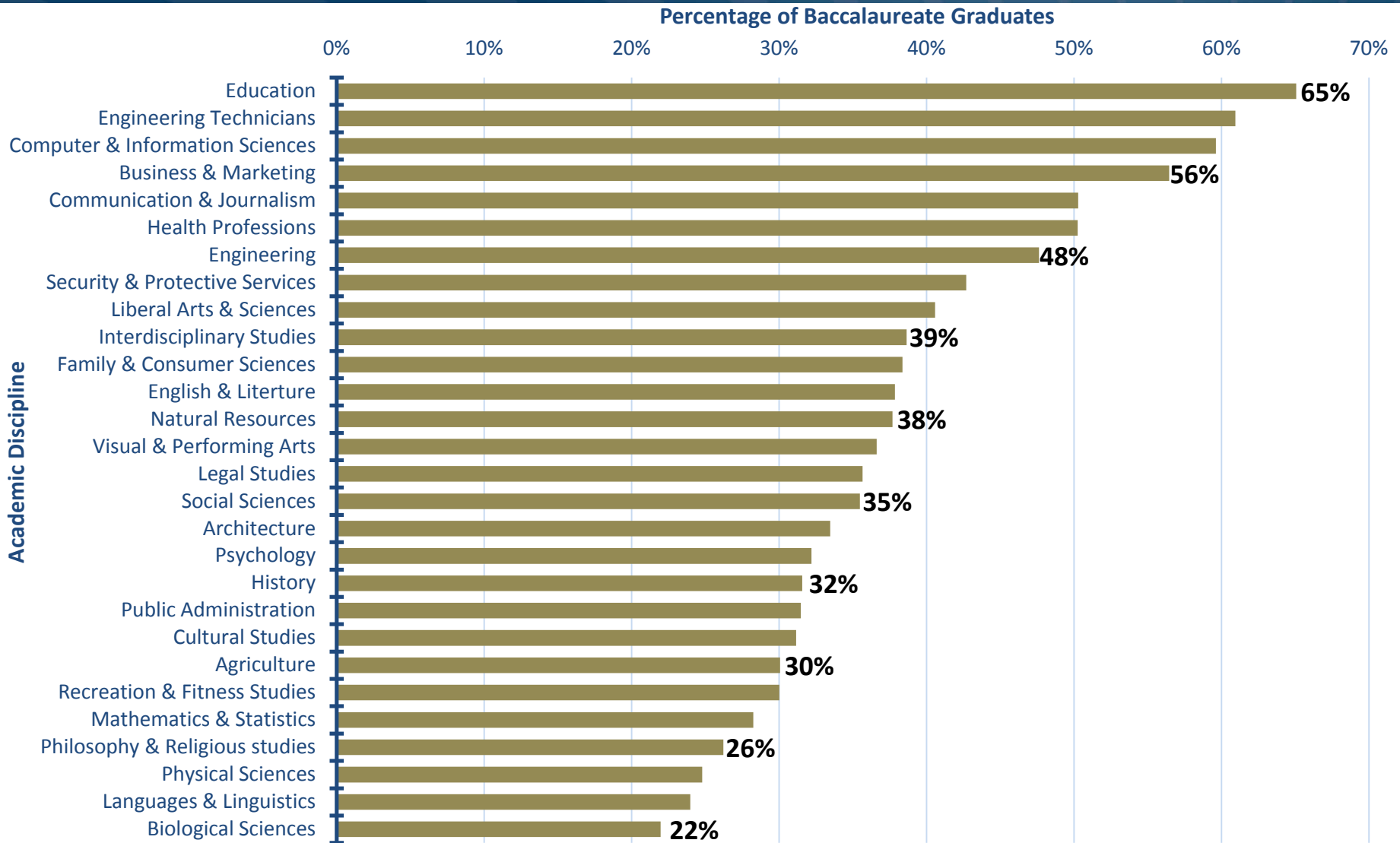

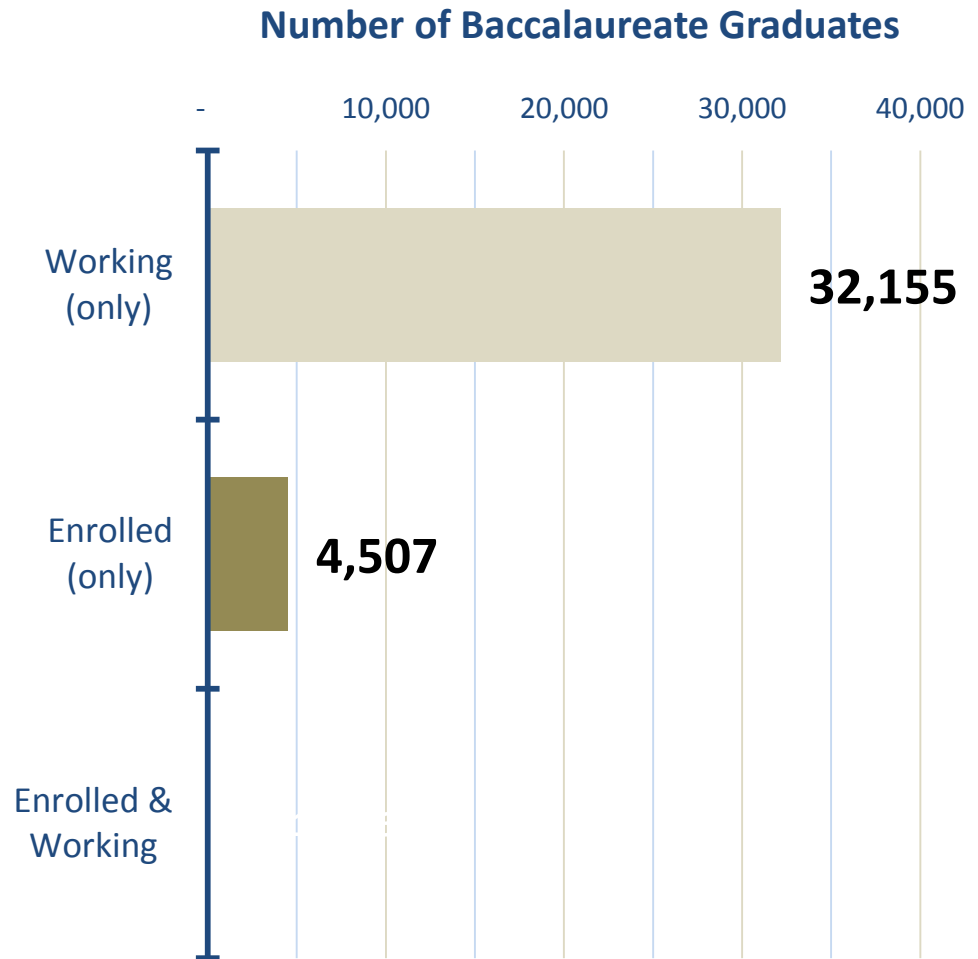
# Baccalaureate Graduates Working Full-time in Florida, by Academic Discipline

- **4,057 – or 9% – of graduates were enrolled in further education**





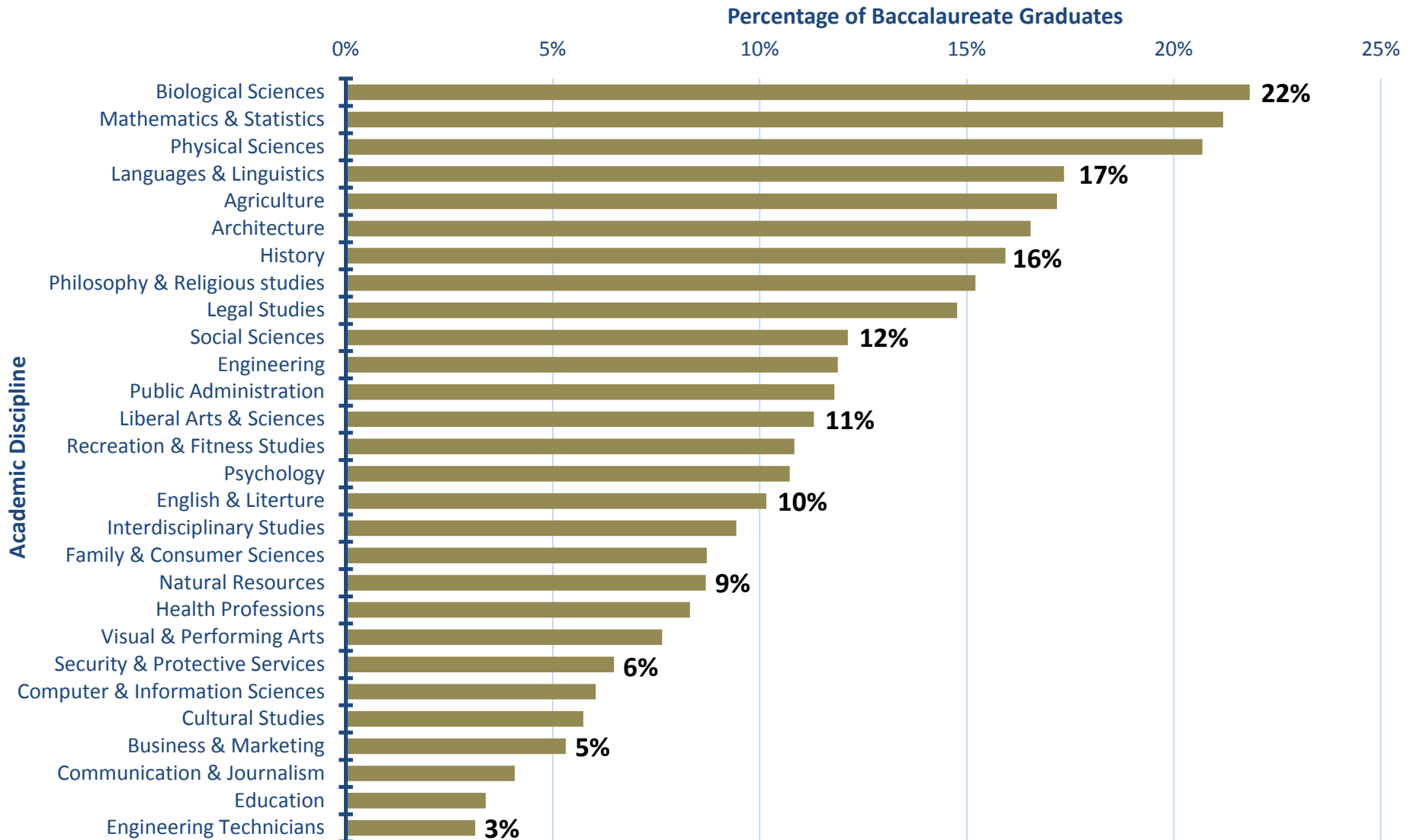

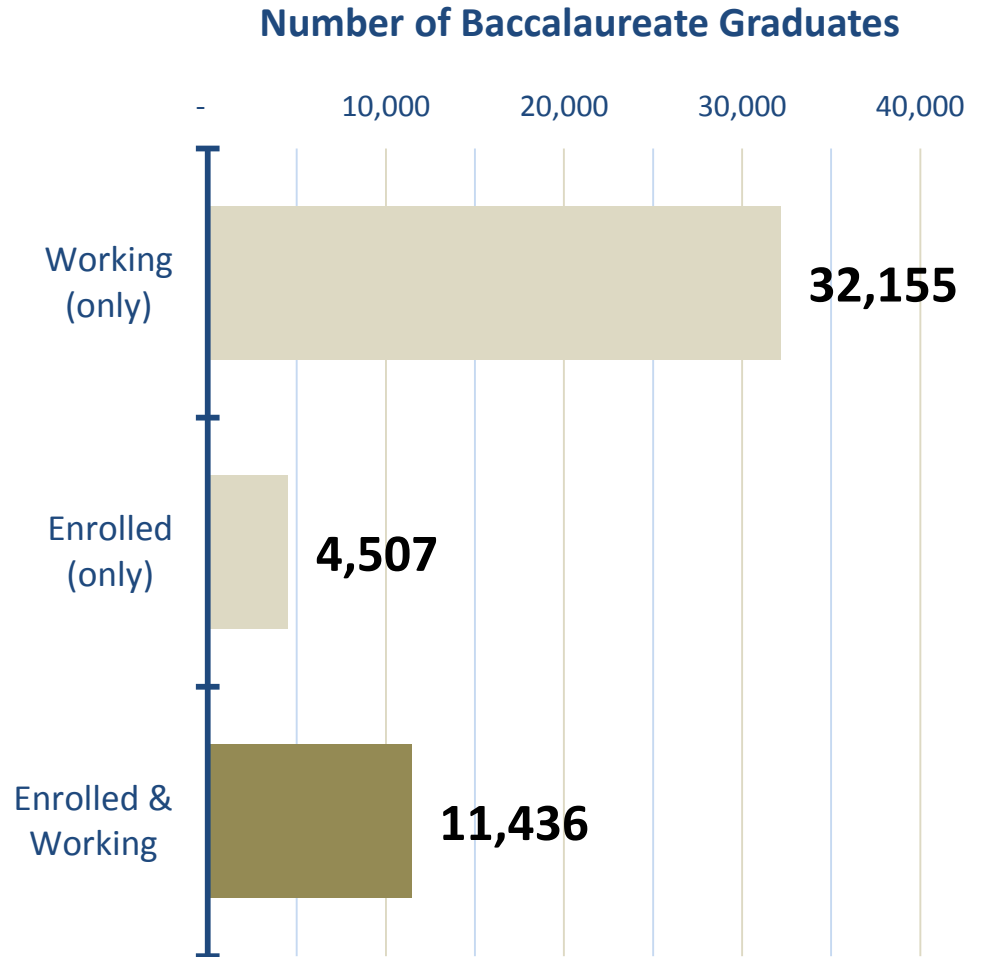
# Baccalaureate Graduates Pursuing Further Education, by Academic Discipline

- 11,436 – or 24% – of graduates were enrolled while working



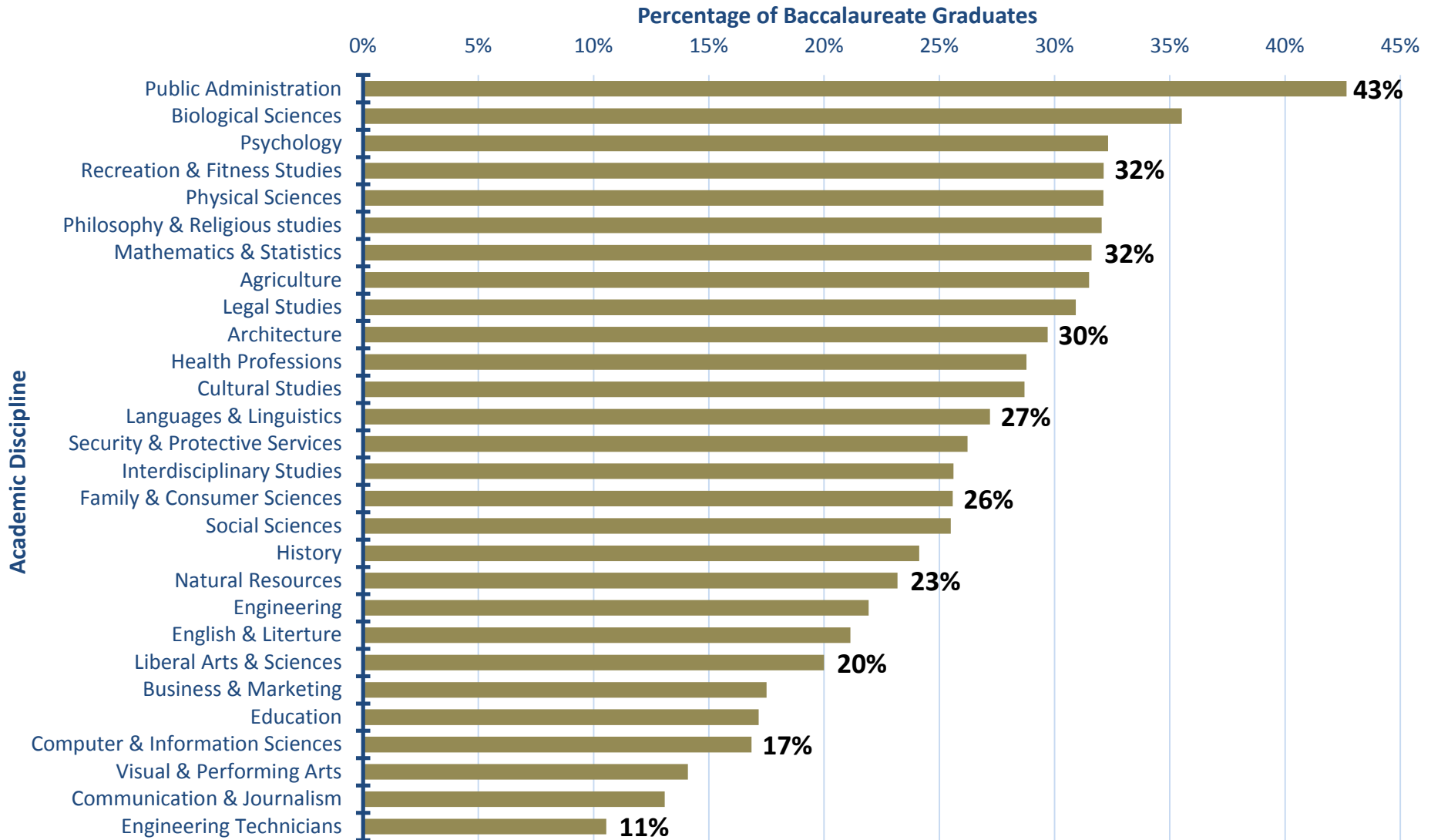

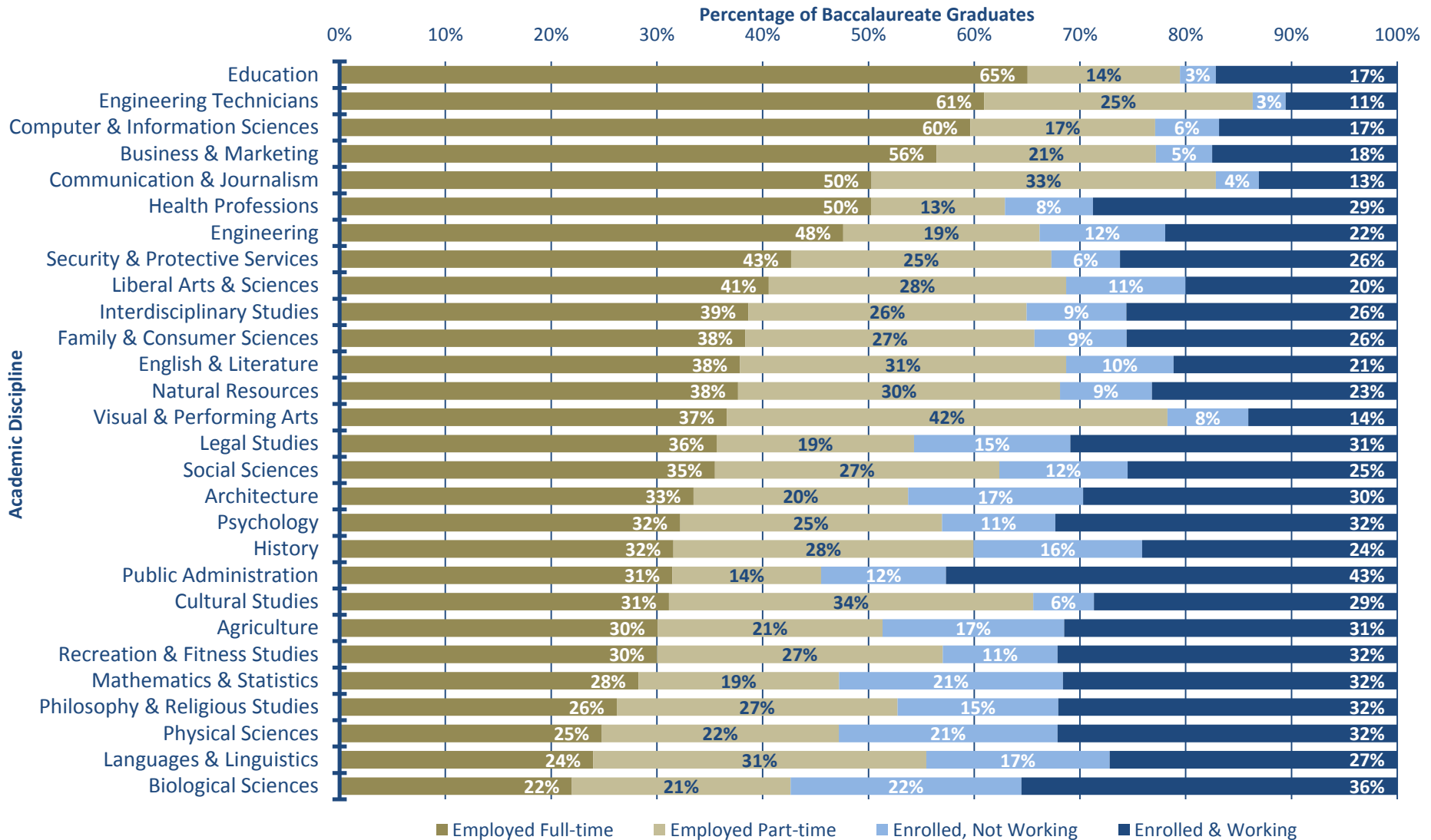


# Baccalaureate Graduates Pursuing Further Education While Working, by Academic Discipline





# Post-baccalaureate Outcome Summary: Percent Working, Enrolled, or Both (by Ac. Discipline)



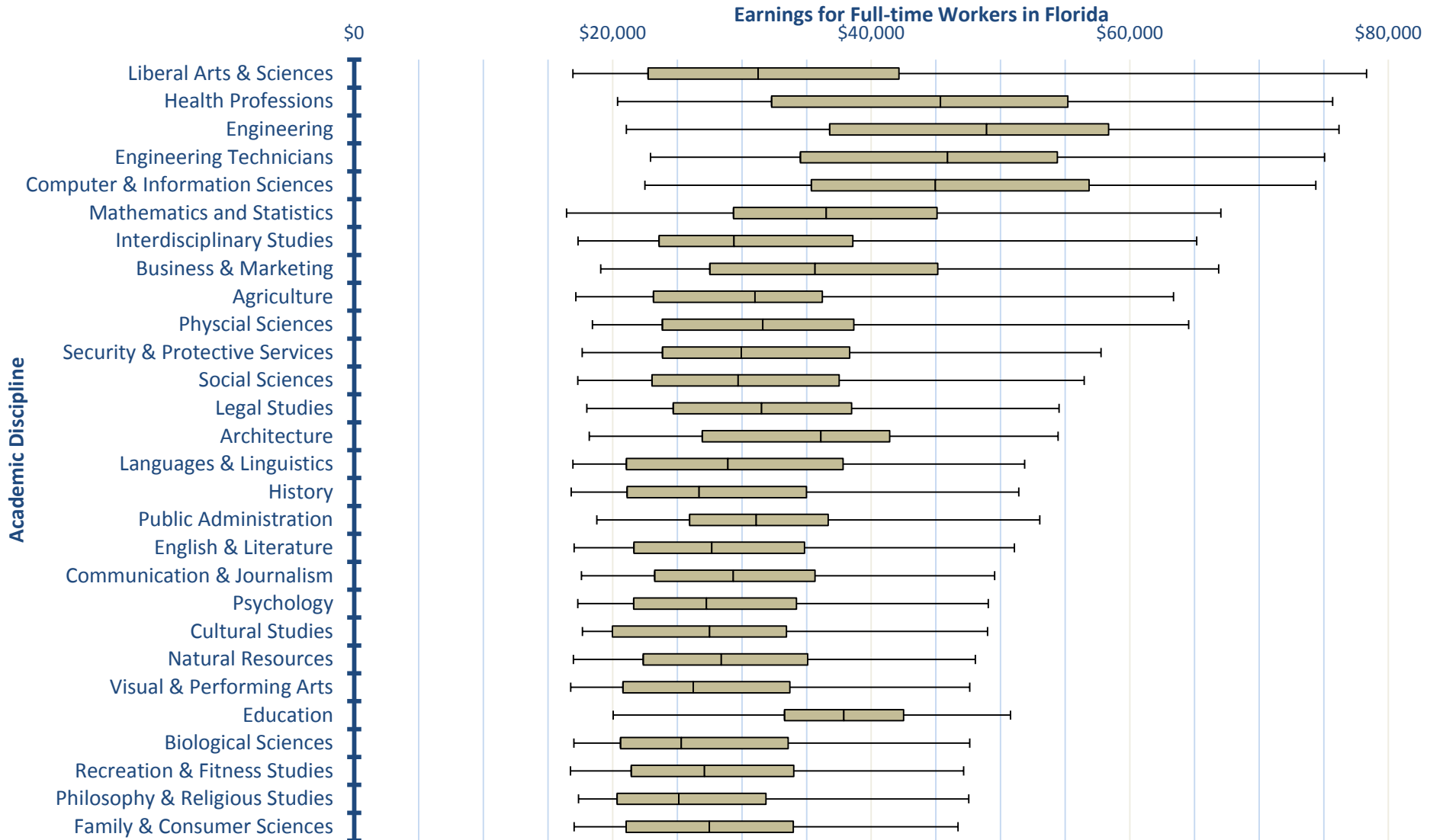


# What Are The Starting Salaries of Graduates Working in Florida?

- **The Median was \$34,000.**
- **Medians Differed for Academic Disciplines**
  - Low: \$25,000 for Philosophy and Religious Studies
  - High: \$49,000 for Engineering
