- Task Force on Online Education
- 9 recommendations
- Rec #7
 - Provide Statewide Faculty Development Center(s) for Online Learning: The BOG and the FCS should select one or more lead institution(s) to develop and implement statewide faculty and administrator development services for online education, using a train-the-trainer approach.
 - In collaboration with Chancellor Hanna's staff, BOG staff should use a competitive procurement process to select a lead institution(s) to be designated as the Faculty Development Center(s).

Online Learning at UCF

- 16 undergraduate degrees
- 24 graduate degrees
- 29 graduate certificates
- Various undergraduate certificates & minors



Strategic Growth: AY 2013-2014

- 35.89% of total university SCH
- 76.18% of all students took at least one online course (W, M, V, RV)
 - 78.34% of all undergraduates (47,116)
 - 62.81% of all graduate students (6,469)




