- **Academic Programs**

- 54 courses offered, 129 sections (Spring 2015)
- 52 faculty, 30 additional hires planned

- **Enrollment**

- Fall 2014: 540 (518/22) students
- Spring 2015: 554 (523/31) students
- Fall 2015: 300% increase in inquiries, 50% increase in deposits

- **Student projects**

- Unique curriculum with matrixed departments and concentrations
- Student competitions resulted in three provisional patent applications

- **Funded Research**
 - Over \$5M in industry funded research
 - Health Care Informatics, Embedded Systems, Energy
- **Future Potential Research**
 - 84 industry partners, 23 interested in sponsoring research
 - On-going discussions with others
