Existing Space Needs

- PECO and CITF are the only allowed sources for both Major Projects (Over \$2 Million); and Minor Projects (Under \$2 Million).
- The Universities will present select high priority Major Projects; but this will total less than 1,000,000 GSF.
- The rest of the system's 70,000,000 GSF (E&G) will need to share whatever is left.

Lump Sum PECO Formula Funding

- Preserve and Maintain Lowest Cost, "Status Quo" option.
- Renovate and Retrofit Higher Cost, Improves
 Functional Use of Space, may also extend the Useful
 Life of the Building.
- Demolish and Replace Highest Cost, Use with Caution. Requires separate approval of both BOT and Board for Demo.

Closing thoughts

- PECO Minor at .\$85 / GSF is not enough "It is allowing us to fall behind at a slower rate".
- A minimum goal might be increase this in total to \$1.00 /GSF
- \$27 M over and above the approved 2017-2018 LBR \$45 M would achieve this; \$10 M increase over 2016/17 amount.
- The appropriation could be in a new FCO Category called:
