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

System Graduation Rates by Student Type





Academic Progress Retention Rate





for Full-time and Part-time FTIC Students





for Full-time FTIC Students who Graduate from Anywhere in the System





Net Tuition & Fees for Resident FTICs in 120 Hour Programs



Percentage of Bachelor's Degrees Awarded **Without Excess Hours**






Headcount Enrollment Trends


Academic Years 2005-06 through 2015-16



Change Between Fall 2011 through Fall 2015





Annual Change in SUS Bachelor's Degrees





PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN DEGREES DURING LAST 5 YEARS




