





### Metric 9: Percent of Baccalaureate Degrees without Excess Hours






### Metric 9: Number of Faculty Awards (FSU & UF) and National Ranking (NCF)










## Metric 9: Percent of Baccalaureate Degrees without Excess Hours (FSU, NCF, & UF)

### Current Allocation Methodology:

- 50 points or less must do an improvement plan.
- Universities not earning the required 50 point threshold or the three lowest scoring universities will not receive any of the state investment.
- Universities receive funds proportional to their existing base.
- Three highest scoring universities eligible for additional state investment funds based on points earned.



### **Allocation Methodologies**

### Alternative Methodology:

- 50 points or less must do an improvement plan.
- Allocate based on university's total points as a percent of total points (all university points combined).

### Alternative Methodology :

- 50 points or less must do an improvement plan.
- Must have at least 66 points to be eligible for the state investment.
- Universities receive a percent allocation up to 75 points before eligible for 100% of their proportional amount.
- Additional state investment funds to schools above 80 points.



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
