

## Central Utility Plant Switchgear and Facility—\$3.2 million

- Mission Critical Project:
   Central Utility Plant provides power, heating and cooling to campus.
- The switchgear serves all but 5 buildings on the main campus.
- Recent evaluation by Dell Consulting showed signs of failure and that replacement of the switchgear should begin as soon as possible.
- With proper maintenance and servicing, the 50-year-old switchgear has exceeded its expected service life.



## Central Utility Plant Switchgear and Facility—\$3.2 million

- Critical to academic and research functions of the University.
- Will provide power distribution, heating and cooling for another 40-50 years for the entire main campus.
- Due to possibility of the switchgear failing, UWF has developed a contingency plan that will be in place before the end of 2017.
- Estimated completion date: **Summer 2020**
