

Definitions of Methods of Instruction

Distance Learning Course	<p>80-100% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both.</p> <p>a. Fully Distance Learning Course (100% of direct instruction) - All special course components (exams, internships, practica, clinicals, labs, etc.) that cannot be completed online can be completed off-campus.</p> <p>b. Primarily Distance Learning Course (80-99% of direct instruction) - There is a requirement for the student to attend campus or another explicit geographic location for a portion of the course.</p>
Hybrid Course	<p>50-79% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both.</p>
Classroom Course	<p>Less than 50% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both. There is a requirement for the student to attend campus or another explicit geographic location for a portion of the course.</p>
