Distance Learning Course	 80-100% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both. a. Fully Distance Learning Course (100% of direct instruction) - All special course components (exams, internships, practica, clinicals, labs, etc.) that cannot be completed online can be completed off-campus. b. Primarily Distance Learning Course (80-99% of direct instruction) - There is a requirement for the student to attend campus or another explicit geographic location for a portion of the course.
Hybrid Course	50-79% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both.
Classroom Course	Less than 50% of the direct instruction of the course is delivered using some form of technology when the student and instructor are separated by time, space, or both. There is a requirement for the student to attend campus or another explicit geographic location for a portion of the course.
