One exception - athletic fee costs associated with changing NCAA divisions may exceed both 5% and 40% limits, but cannot exceed \$2 per credit hour. Increases must be recommended by fee committee and may only be implemented in the fall term.

Increases may occur once a year and be implemented in the fall term. Proposed reductions must be analyzed by the Division of Bond Finance and subsequently approved by the Board of Governors.

6	Distance Learning Fee		X			Average fee assessed by a university may not exceed \$30 per credit hour. Per Florida statute, the amount of the distance learning course fee may not exceed the additional costs of the services provided which are attributable to the development and delivery of the distance learning course.

8	Excess Hour Fee		X			Students entering fall 2009 or later but before fall 2011 pay a fee of 50% of undergrad tuition per credit hour for hours over 120% necessary for their degree; students entering in fall 2011 or later but before fall 2012 pay a fee of 100% of undergrad tuition for hours over 115% necessary; students entering in fall 2012 through spring 2019 pay a fee of 100% of undergrad tuition over 110% necessary; students entering in summer 2019 or later pay a fee of 100% of undergrad tuition for hours over 120% of necessary.

28	Housing Rental Rates	X			Rental rates set by each university.
29	Parking Fines, Permits and Decals	X			Amounts established by university board of trustees.
30	Transportation Access Fee	X			Amount established by university board of trustees "with appropriate input from students", however, no official student committee is required.
31	Returned Check Fee	X			Fee as authorized by 832.07, F.S., and established by university board of trustees.
32	Collection Costs	X			Charge representing the "reasonable cost" of efforts to collect on overdue accounts.
33	Service Charge (on university loans)	X			In lieu of interest and administrative handling charges.

41	International Student Service Fee	X			As established by university board of trustees. Offsets the university costs associated with reporting requirements of the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System administered by the Department of Homeland Security for F-Visa and J-Visa degree seeking students.
42	Convenience Fee for Credit, Charge, and Debit cards	X			Established by university board of trustees; shall not be greater than the cost to provide the service.
43	Miscellaneous Health-Related Charges	X			Fees established by university board of trustees for services provided at cost by the university health center which are not covered by the health fee (s. 1009.24(14)(h), F.S., not in BOG Regulation)
44	Optional Fees Related to Specific Activities	X			Allowed only if not required as part of registration for courses.
