**PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION**

Consider approval of the Public Notice of Intent to Amend Board of Governors Regulation 6.006 Accelerated Mechanisms.

**AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION**

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Board of Governors Regulation 6.006 specifies how State University System institutions recognize and apply credit for accelerated mechanisms. The proposed amendment clarifies that the test identified in subsection (4)(b) is the placement test specified in Regulation 6.008, Postsecondary College-level Preparatory Testing, Placement, and Instruction for State Universities. This test and concordant scores from other national exams are utilized in different dual enrollment situations and the standard admission criteria for first-time-in-college undergraduate students.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the Notice of Intent to Amend Regulation 6.006, Accelerated Mechanisms, will be available for public comment for thirty days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval at the next meeting.
