BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The FAMU-FSU College of Engineering is a joint venture between Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University (FAMU) and Florida State University (FSU) established by the Florida legislature 39 years ago. It is currently funded through a combination of an annual appropriation from the state legislature and supplemental funding provided by FAMU and FSU. The College of Engineering is requesting \$6,620,000 in recurring funding to support several ongoing efforts of the college.

The college plans to use the funding to (1) recruit additional joint college faculty researchers; (2) provide start-up funds and research equipment for faculty; (3) provide support for undergraduate student success; (4) strengthen graduate programs; and (5) improve faculty retention and vitality.

Dr. J. Murray Gibson, dean of the joint college, will provide an overview of the request.
