November of 2019 reduced sport sponsorship by cutting Men's Tennis & Men's Cross Country

Reduced scholarship expenses with the use of allowable sources

Hired a new VP and Director of Athletics and reorganized the athletic administration structure with total budget authority over the Division of Athletics

>At the onset of the pandemic the Athletic staff took a 7% percent pay reduction to help bring the budget into balance

>Implemented expense controls

>Enhanced fundraising efforts

The Athletic Division has been able to have the latitude to make qualified decisions based on best practice and execute to ensure departmental growth and compliance; hence establishing the third consecutive year of a balanced athletics budget
