<u>AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION</u>

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution; Board of Governors Regulation 2.002

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board Regulation 2.002 requires the Board of Governors to annually submit a State University System summary to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. At its June 2021 meeting, the Strategic Planning Committee considered approval of 2021 accountability plans. In addition, the committee considered the annual university preeminence status updates for Florida State University, the University of Florida, and the University of South Florida and the emerging preeminence updates for Florida International University and the University of Central Florida. At its August 31 meeting, Strategic Planning Committee considered approval of updates to the following plans: New College of Florida, the University of South Florida, and Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University.

Based on the data and information provided in the institutional accountability plans, Board staff analyzed system-level data and trends for key performance indicators. The System Accountability Plan also includes system information on specialized accreditation, student learning outcomes, institutes and centers, and academic program actions.

If approved by the Strategic Planning Committee, the 2021 System Accountability Plan will be forwarded to the Full Board for consideration.
