Where do we get employment & wage data for SUS graduates?





Reemployment Assistance

Program (for graduates employed in Florida) Administered by Department of Revenue



State Wage Interchange System (SWIS)

(for graduates employed outside of Florida)

Administered by U.S. Department of Labor



DEO provides wage & employment data for SUS graduates to the Board office

Who is included in the current employment & wage data?





More than **95%** of all employees working in **Florida**

Employees found working in all 50 states

Employment data includes most SUS graduates

Who is NOT included in the current employment & wage data?



The Florida reemployment assistance & SWIS databases do not contain information for all individuals who actually worked

Examples include those who...



were employed outside the United States



provided services as a sole proprietor



were employed in temporary positions not eligible for unemployment insurance



were employed by the military or federal government



provided services for a school, college, or university & were also a student enrolled and attending classes



performed services as a student nurse at a hospital or a nurse training school, or as an intern in a hospital



did not have a valid Social Security number
