1) CDE = FAMU-FSU College of Engineering. In light of its separate and distinct operating appropriation in the GAA, as well as its unique Governance Council, for the purpose of the above process, COE is considered a state university, with a Total NASF of 221,457. The Governance Council has indicated that FAMU-FSU College of Engineering Bldg. C is its #1 priority project.

In the event of a tie score between projects, the project with the lowest Remaining PECO Need will be given priority.
In the event of a tie score between projects, generally speaking. May also include Carryforward funds, as is the case with FGCU and UNF.
In the case of multiple projects per university, the cumulative Total Needs Met should not exceed the university's Total Unnet Space Need.
