BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board Regulation 8.012, Academic Program Termination and Temporary Suspension of New Enrollments, permits university boards of trustees to recommend termination of degree programs at the doctoral or professional level to the Board of Governors.

Florida State University is requesting termination of the Ph.D. in Interdisciplinary Humanities, CIP 24.0103 due to low enrollment. New enrollments in the program have been suspended since fall 2020, and there are no students currently enrolled in the program. The Florida State University Board of Trustees approved the termination request on November 12, 2021.

If approved by the Academic and Student Affairs Committee and the Board of Governors, the program termination will be effective spring 2022 with a phase-out term of summer 2022.
