# Overview of Programs



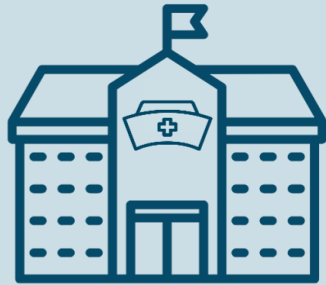
**10 institutions offer 38 nursing programs**

20 of these programs are at the pre-licensure level

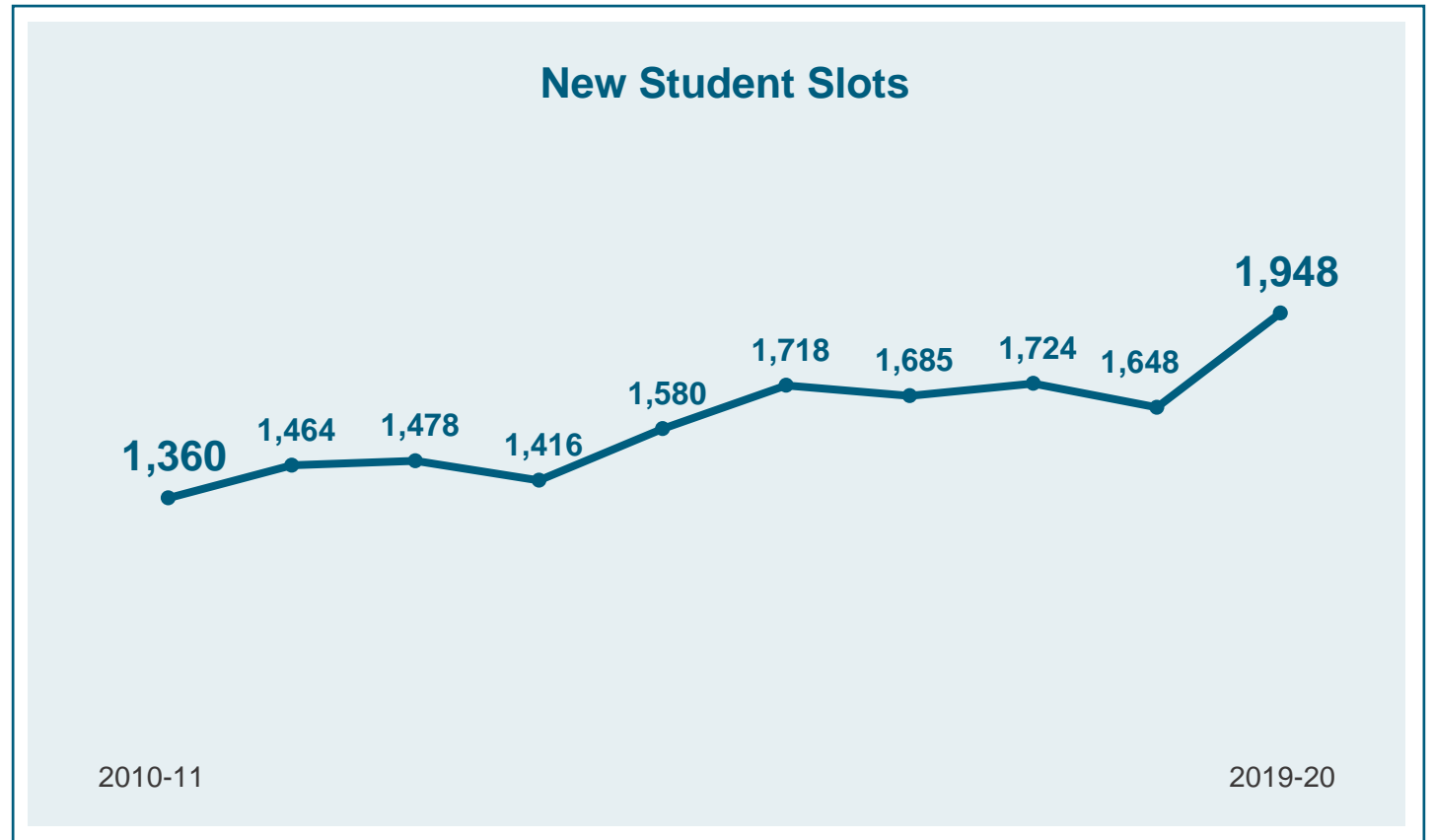

Pre-licensure program slots increased by 43% over the past 10 years



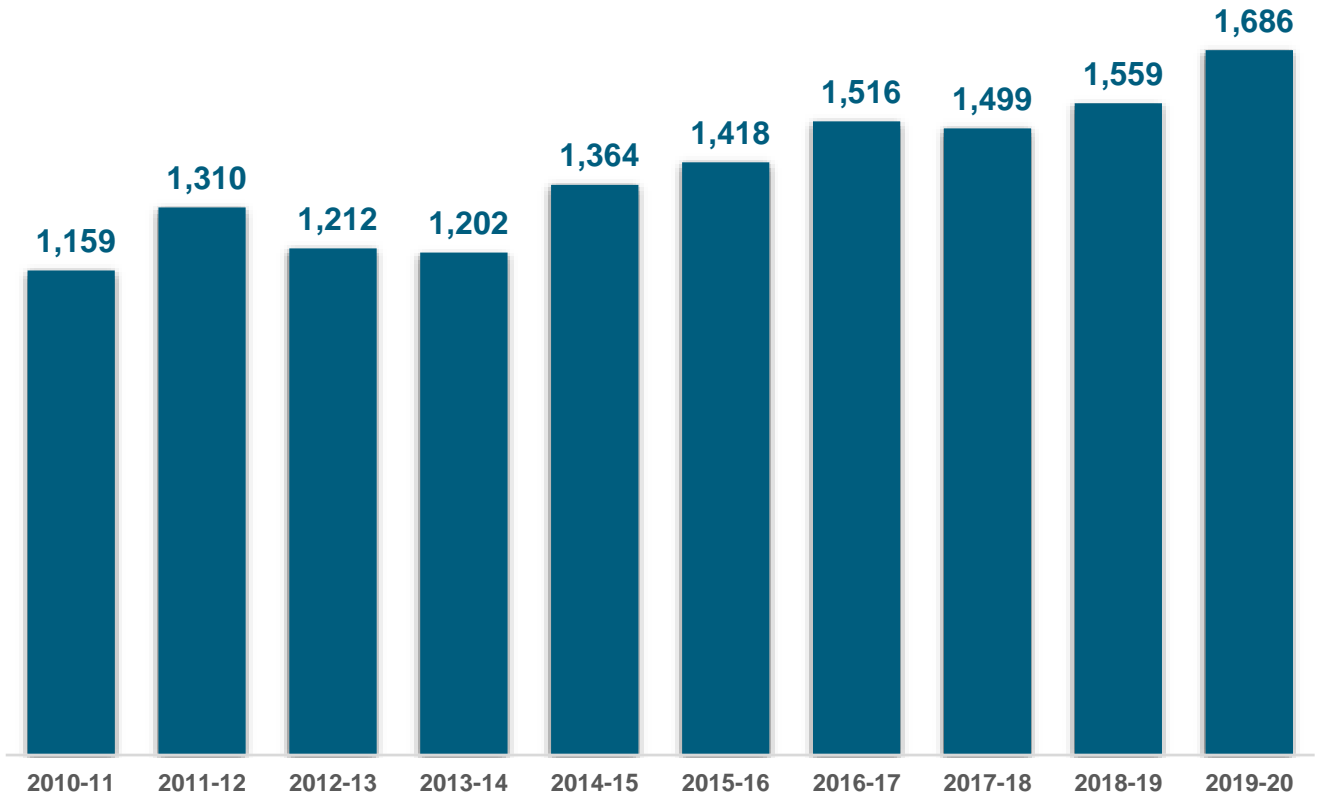

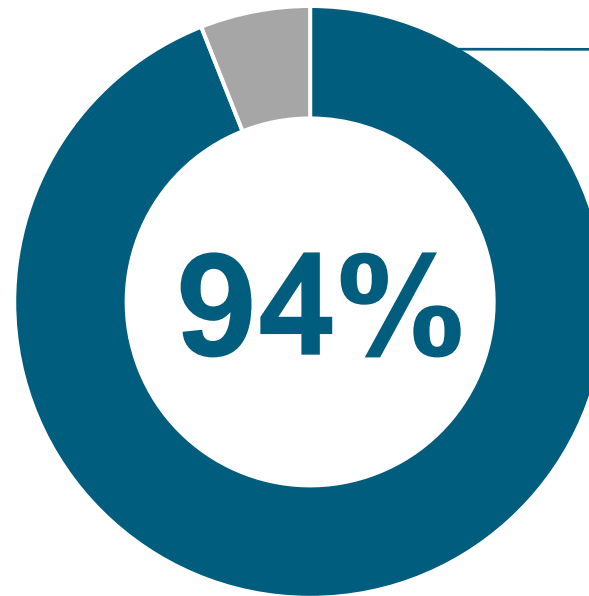

## 2020 NCLEX Passage Rate

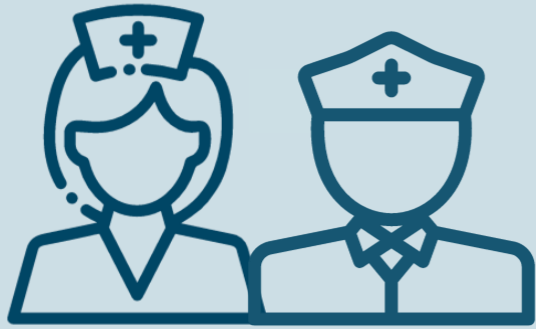


The vast majority of Florida graduates pass the NCLEX exam

96% of these students passed the exam on the first try!

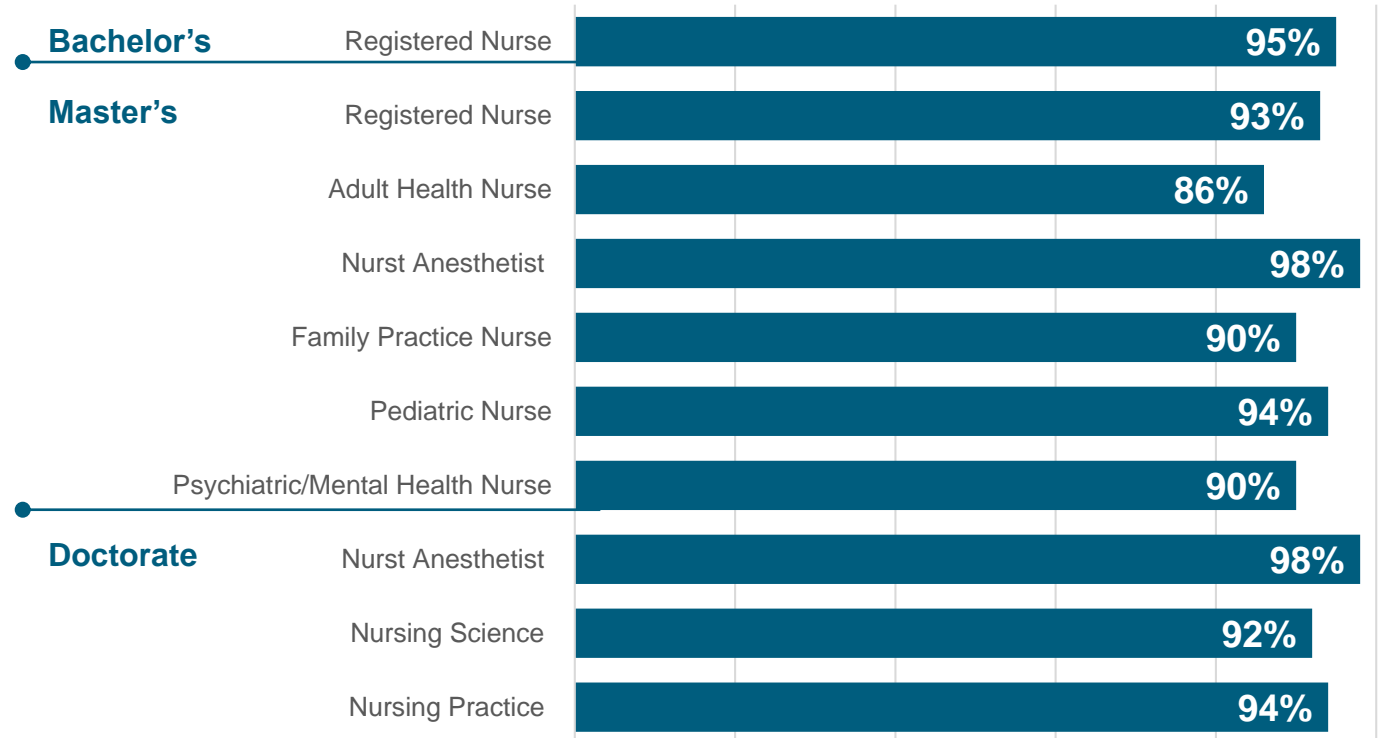

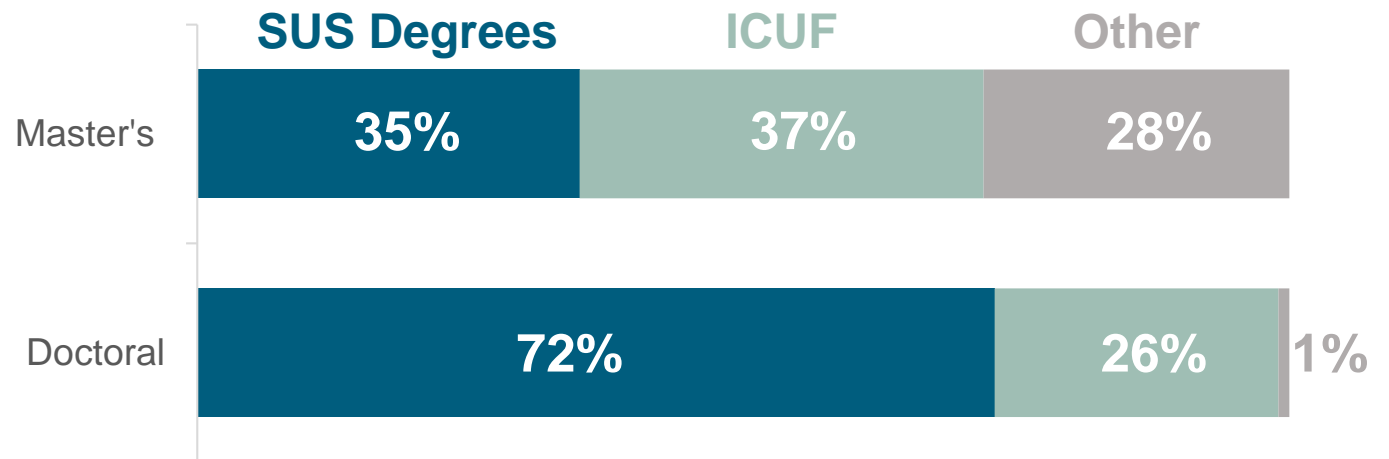


# Graduate Nursing Degrees Awarded

## Graduate Nursing Degrees Awarded by Type (2019-20)



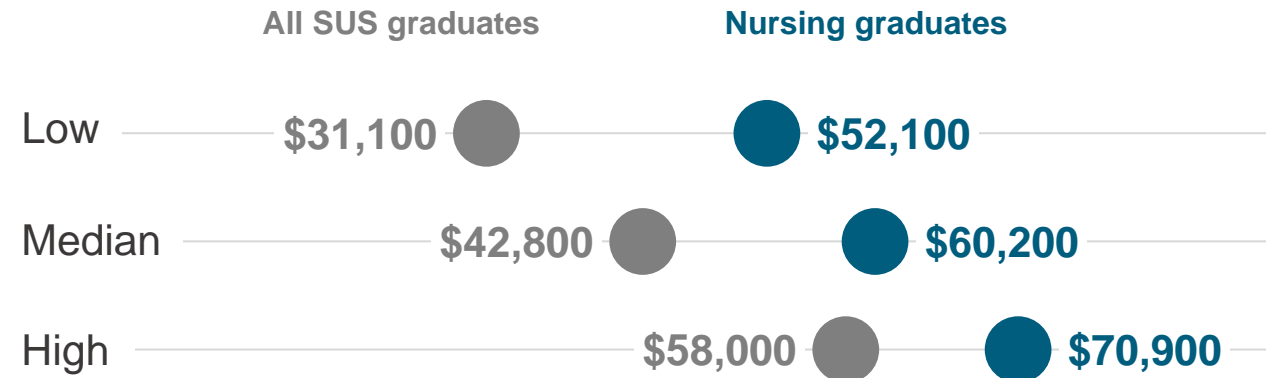
